# Honorary hairman By JoAnn M. Macdonald

eet Bryon Bodt, Honorary Chairman of the 27th Annual Havre de Grace Decoy Museum Wildlife and Art Festival. Considered one of the younger carvers, Bryon Bodt is quietly passionate about his life work. Carving decoys began as a hobby, as most carvers will tell you about themselves. However, Bryon is doing what many people long to do. He is doing what he loves to do. every day. For over twenty-two years this has been a full-time business—carving and re-creating the beautiful birds of the Chesapeake Bay such as hens and drakes of most species of ducks as well as Canada geese, snow geese, blue geese and swans.

The passion began when he was a teen in 1977 and began to carve duck heads. His father, Bernie Bodt, inspired Bryon's interest in birds and the environment in which we live by instilling in Bryon a love of antique decoys and hunting. They hunted together around Havre de Grace, particularly on the Susquehanna Flats, and still do. Bernie is a part-time working companion, and enjoys working with his son. Bryon said that his father turns most of the bird bodies. Bernie made it clear that he "works for Bryon, not the other way around." He helps to sand, prime, and paint. "We're team painters," Bernie said firmly, making certain that I understood. And I did.

When I visited Bryon at his Churchville workshop in mid-January, he informed me about the many details with which only carvers and their admirers are familiar: using hand tools such as whittling knives, the Surform<sup>™</sup>, the spoke shave and the drawknife. His shop is fully equipped and neat, although there were just enough shavings on the floor to tell the tale. This IS a working business. For twenty years he worked in a cold and drafty space which was half the size of his current shop and was heated by a wood-burning stove. This shop has more floor space in which to move around and room for the two band saws, vices, a belt sander and a pneumatic drum sander. It was a warm and cozy place on a very cold day. He was planning on goose hunting that afternoon if the weather was favorable. It was.

Down to business: Bryon begins with a block of basswood and carves out the duck or goose head. White pine is used for the bodies of the birds. The bodies and heads are joined after whittling, shaping and sanding on both parts. Then they are ready for the base coat. These last sentences may make the work sound trivial. It is not. For Bryon it is important work that he does with pride. There may be as many as five coats of paint including the final top coat with feathering before he considers the decoy finished.

Bryon is often asked this question, "How long does it take to make a duck?" He answers with a logical explanation of doing the steps in batches, so it is difficult to say how long it takes to make an individual duck. The efficiency of working with a comfortable number of birds that are undergoing the same step whether it is





By the end of week three, the final week of the project, two males and one female were seen working on one of the mud mounds, a nest, which the scientists had made. "One male appeared to inspect one of the artificial eggs," Nora Rojek wrote Bryon. She sent pictures of the beautiful pink decoy flamingos standing in the turquoise blue salt pond water and sitting on the shore at the water's edge, confirming Bryon's success. The e-mail accounts the scientist sent were fascinating! Truly, this was one of the high points in his career.

Bryon's style of carving is patterned after the classic wooden working decoys produced by Bob McGaw, R. Madison Mitchell, Paul Gibson, and Charlie Bryan, all familiar names in the collecting community. The traditional working birds (gunning decoys) are characterized by their flat paint, absence of raised feathers, and presence of ballast weights and anchor rings. For three years in the early 1980's Bryon served as an apprentice to

Jim (Jimmy) Pierce, a renowned Havre de Grace Decoy maker. Bryon's style emerged in his thirty years' experience—the total number of years he has been carving, whittling, sanding, and painting.

Bryon Bodt is a man of and for the land. Since 1981, when he graduated from Bel Air High School, Harford County has seen its rural nature disappear. There is less available land on which to hunt and

otherwise enjoy the outdoors. Here, as in other areas around the Chesapeake Bay, the encroaching human population challenges habitats of all species of wildlife. "We are stewards of the land," Bryon reminds us.

His interest in wildlife and their environment in Harford County led to his earning the Bachelor of Science degree in Biology from Washington College (Kent County) in 1985. He is a life member of the Harford County Chapter of the Izaak Walton League of America (IWLA) and served as its vice president and membership director. The IWLA is an organization dedicated to protecting our nation's soil, air, woods, water and wildlife.

Bryon's dedication to wildlife is evident in his working with groups of students who check the nesting boxes in midspring for the presence of wood ducks.

He told me that he and a partner clean out the nesting boxes in February so they are ready for the wood ducks when they mate. And February around the Chesapeake Bay is an unpredictable month. Checking on and cleaning out nesting boxes on a cold day may not be most folks' idea of having fun in the outdoors. However, Bryon told me he does enjoy this time of year in the marsh. And, as with any water environment, cold and ice need to be respected in the marsh but not feared. It may appear to be bleak. Far from it though—a lot of things are happening there. Beavers are cutting down trees, otters are catching fish, many species of waterfowl are migrating, and skunk cabbage is peeking through the ground. What's more, there are no biting insects! As it turned out, Bryon checked about 40 of the 80 nesting boxes without his partner. He assured me he enjoyed his day in the marsh: an eagle soared overhead.

During the 1980's and 1990's Bryon displayed his decoys at the well-attended

shows and wildlife festivals, thereby furthering his reputation in the decoy-making community. In recent years he participated in The Upper Shore Decoy Show and The Chestertown Wildlife Show. In this year's Havre de Grace Decoy Museum Wildlife and Art Festival Auction, as in years past, Bryon's decoys are among the offerings. Be sure to see and bid on his beautiful decoys! The distinguished book of decoy history *Upper Chesapeake Bay Decoys and Their Makers* by David Hagan & Joan Hagan (1997) featured Bryon's work.
